Please note:

- ▶ Boats not permitted to approach dolphins within 100m: Jetskis not permitted to approach dolphins within 300m
- ▶ In narrow waters, you cannot approach closer than 30m – unless navigating for safe passage
- ▶ If deliberately approaching dolphins closer than prescribed you may be liable for prosecution
